

Havasu Stitchers – BOM Part 2

September 2015 – August 2016

The Project

Are you excited? Have you glanced through the *Farm Girl Vintage* book yet? Did you notice some of the blocks have embroidery embellishments which use 3-strand floss and primarily backstitch?

To keep the project exciting and not just parse our way through the Farm Girl Sampler quilt, I've given the schedule below for the four blocks that will be assigned each month. Two block participants have the choice of creating any two of the four assigned for their project. This will also give you a chance to work ahead since these blocks are SEW much fun to make.

Be sure to check out the LQS offerings this month again available at the BOM table. Please note, some of our LQs have created the September blocks using their bundles, which will give you an idea of what the completed blocks look like made up in their bundle offerings.

Note: There are 45 blocks in this pattern; since there are 48 needed to finish the full size quilt, August of next year will allow you to make 3 (or 1 for the 2 block program) blocks of your choice to complete the 48 blocks needed. Each month, the *Dangling Thread* will identify the 4 blocks assigned for the previous month.
