Concierge "The" Pocket - Instructions



A hint for turning twice - Place the folded $3\frac{1}{2} \times 7$ " to the opposite end from where the ribbon has been attached with raw edges together. Then, place the $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " square right sides together on top of the ribbon, again raw edges together. This piece will sit about $\frac{1}{2}$ " up from the bottom. Then sew all 4 sides together. And turn. Hope this helps

“The” Pocket - Instructions

Listed here are the instructions and fabric requirements to complete one (1) “THE” POCKET.

Fabric Requirements

3½”x 15” strip of fabric

7” piece of ribbon (Ribbon can be any width - preferably no wider than ¾”-1”)

Cutting Instructions

Sub-cut 3½” x 15” strip into three pieces

3½” x 7” rectangle (A)

3½” x 4½” rectangle (B)

3½” x 3½” square (C)

Assembly

With **WRONG** sides together, press the 3½” x 7” rectangle in half. This should measure 3½”x 3½”.

Fold the 7” piece of ribbon in half. With the loop of the ribbon to the fabric, center and pin to the seam line of the 3½” side of B rectangle (3½” x 4½”). The two raw edges of the ribbon should “rest” a little above the seam line. Sew ribbon in place.

Place the folded (A rectangle), now measuring 3½” x 3½”, to the bottom of the B rectangle (3½” x 4½”). Align the raw edges of A & B. The fold of A should be 1” from the top of B.

With **RIGHT** sides together, place the C square (3½” x 3½”) to the top of the A/B unit. Align the raw edges of A & C.

Stitch a ¼” seam around the entire Pocket. Be sure to leave the bottom of the C square open. DO NOT secure it to the unit. It needs to be left open so the Pocket can be turned.

Trim the corners and turn twice.

Press, and you’re done.
